- have a significant influence from or over HESTA, or
- are an entity whose Key Management Personnel include an Executive Officer or Board member of HESTA, or their associates.

Please note that the reference to 'related party payments' in Annual Member Meeting disclosure regulations is different from accounting standards which govern financial statement disclosures.
